

## **NATIONAL CAREER SERVICE PROJECT :**

National Career Service project was launched in July 2015, by the Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India with a vision to interlink all the State Employment Exchanges with the National Career Service Platform. In this context, a scheme has been evolved and finalised to upgrade the infrastructure across all employment exchanges with partial funding and facilitate job fairs through the NCS platforms. The Ministry of Labour and Employment provides funds for basic IT infrastructure, minor re-furbishing of the employment exchanges and for organising job fairs at the district level. An outlay of Rs.16,21,000/- was earmarked for the year 2017-18, out of which an amount of Rs.2,00,000/- incurred towards conduct of job fairs in which more than 4500 candidates attended and 419 candidates secured jobs in various sectors.

In Puducherry Region, one more conduct job fair was conducted on 29/09/2018 at Govt. ITI, Mettupalayam, Puducherry and 800 candidates were participated and 281 candidates secured jobs in various sectors. The remaining two jobs fair will be conducted during the months of January & March 2019 in Karaikal and Puducherry region respectively.

The Employment Officer, Karaikal has proposed to spent the amount of Rs.1,80,000/- towards purchase of IT equipment and Rs.3,70,000/- towards refurbishing work during the current financial year in the earmarked amount to Karaikal region.

## **SETTING UP OF MODEL CAREER CENTRE (MCC) :**

The Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India has decided to transform Employment Exchange to Model Career Centre(MCC) with increased focus on career counselling with the collaboration with State Government. Model Career Centre aims to empower youth with essential attitude and skill set. This platform gives the power to them to achieve their career goals in life. MCC also aims to provide complete guidance and counselling through self-assessments & insights into making right career choices. The total project of cost is Rs.39.00 lakhs out of which an amount of Rs.23.52 lakhs has been released as a first installment and the same has been incurred for the purpose for which it was allocated. An amount of Rs.7,84,100/- has been released as second installment on 08/09/2018.
