

## **NATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP PROMOTION SCHEME (NAPS)**

Apprenticeship training is one of the most efficient ways to develop skilled manpower for industry by using training facilities available in the establishments without putting any extra burden on exchequer to set up training infrastructure. Keeping in view of the importance of Apprenticeship training for Promoting Apprenticeship Training through incentivising the employer, a new scheme "National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS)" was launched on 19-08-2016. The scheme provides for:-

- Reimbursement of 25% of prescribed stipend subject to a maximum of Rs. 1500/- per month per apprentice to all employers.
- Sharing of basic training cost in respect of apprentices who come directly to apprenticeship training without any formal training. Basic Training Provider upto Rs. 7500/- for a maximum of 500 hours/3 months.

It is proposed to reimburse the stipend amount @ Rs. 1500/-per month per apprentice to 250 apprentices for 12 months, which amounting around to Rs. 50 lakhs. At present, an amount of Rs. 23/- is available, and for remaining Rs. 30 lakh, proposal seeking release of fund has been sent to Govt. of India vide letter dated 27-04-2018.
